Support of the National Apprenticeship Programs

We, the Indian and Native American Grantees of the National Indian and Native American Employment/Public Law 102-477 Training Conference (NINAETC/477) attending the 39th Annual Conference in Marksville, Louisiana, in order to preserve for ourselves and our descendants rights secured under Indian Treaties and benefits to which we are entitled under the laws and constitution of the United States and the several states, to enlighten the public toward a better understanding of the Native people, to preserve Indian and Native cultural values, and otherwise promote the welfare of the Indian and Native people, do hereby establish and submit the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the NINAETC/477 are the representatives of and advocates for national, regional, and tribal concerns; and

WHEREAS, the NINAETC/477 is a national organization comprised of American Indians, Alaska Natives, and Native Hawaiians; and

WHEREAS, the health, safety, welfare, education, economic and employment opportunity and preservation of cultural and natural resources are primary goals and objectives of NINAETC/477; and

WHEREAS, the NINAETC/477 support the Registered Apprenticeships and skills offered by Union and Non-Union Organizations to further the advancement of Native Americans, Native Alaskans, and Native Hawaiian.

WHEREAS, Registered Apprenticeships can be leveraged through partnerships with Native American communities, post-secondary/secondary educational programs to extend opportunities to employers/local workforce.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the 39th National Indian and Native American Employment/Public Law 102-477 Training Conference does hereby promote the apprenticeship partnerships with Union and Non-Union Organizations as outlined by the U.S. Department of Labor.
